1 Opening remarks

Tim Hansen called the meeting to order at 17:04.

2 ESTA declarations

2.1 Reading of the anti-trust statement

Tim Hansen read the following statement aloud to the assembly:

ESTA and its members take seriously their obligation to comply with all applicable antitrust laws. Therefore, during this meeting and during all ESTA events, all discussions will be limited to those subjects that are permitted by the antitrust laws. All members should refrain from any discussion or mention of competitively sensitive subjects such as the current or future prices charged for any member product or services, current or future marketing plans or strategies, and current or future costs, including employee salaries. There also must be no agreement on the suppliers or customers that members will do business with or the markets in which members will conduct business.

Violations of the antitrust laws can have serious consequences. If you have any questions or concerns about anything that is discussed at a ESTA meeting, please bring your concern to ESTA management. An easy to read pamphlet describing the antitrust laws is available from the ESTA staff.

2.2 Reading of the call for patents

Tim Hansen read the following statement aloud to the assembly:

ESTA intends not to publish any standard that contains protected intellectual property, unless that information can be licensed by anyone for a reasonable fee. ESTA uses a process of open patent and copyright disclosures to implement its intent. ESTA does not conduct patent or copyright searches and does not warrant that its standards contain no protected intellectual property.

In keeping with the open disclosures policy, I ask if anyone present wishes to notify this working group of the existence of a patent, patent application, copyright, or other protected intellectual property that might protect material in a standard being developed by this working group. You need not be the holder of the patent or copyright to notify this working group of its existence.

Nothing was revealed.

3 Attendance and Membership

3.1 Requirements for membership

Tim Hansen read the following statement aloud to the assembly:

Membership is open to all parties who are affected by the work of the group; membership in ESTA is not a requirement, but there is a \$100/person/year participation fee to help fund running the Technical Standards Program. New applications shall not be processed until after the participation fee has been paid. Voting members are required to attend meetings. Any principal member and alternate that both miss three consecutive meetings or that miss three consecutive letter ballots will have their membership status changed to observer; either class of inaction shall result in a loss of voting status. This action will be taken at the beginning of the first meeting after such inaction and will be recorded in the minutes of that meeting.

3.2 Introduction of attendees

3.3 Determination of a quorum

The voting body as of today's meeting is 11. A quorum is four. A supermajority vote requires at least six.

Karl Ruling announced that enough voters were present to pass a supermajority vote.

Steve Serafin reported. He explained the extent of changes, which was slight: They added two definitions: "risk" and "stage floor", and pulled the risk assessment language from ANSI E1.72. Bruce Darden asked to open the document and review the examples to ensure they were appropriate. Slight change were made to remove references to stage machinery – all in section 4 – to everyone's agreement.

Steve moved to send the revised draft to public review. The motion was seconded, and carried without objection or abstention. The revised draft will be sent to the TSC for consideration, then a BSR8 will be filed, and a PR will commence soon thereafter.
