3 Approval of minutes from the previous meeting

Eddie Kramer moved that the 24 January 2013 minutes be accepted. The move was seconded and approved by a show of hands.

4 PLASA declarations

4.1 Anti-trust statement

The following was read aloud to the assembly by Bill Sapsis:

"The PLASA Board of Directors, the Technical Standards Council, and the leadership of this working group will reject or nullify any actions that unlawfully restrain trade. Anyone who feels that such an action is being or has been taken is requested to bring that matter to the attention of the chair immediately. Anyone who feels that actions in restraint of trade have been taken and not properly annulled is requested to notify the TSC chair or PLASA chair immediately.

"PLASA legal counsel has informed us that violations of the anti-trust laws can have serious consequences. Individuals engaged in certain unlawful conduct can be found criminally liable. An individual convicted of a criminal violation of the Sherman Act may be fined as much as \$1,000,000 and imprisoned for up to ten years. An easy to read pamphlet describing restraint of trade issues is available from the Technical Standards Manager."

No anti-trust issues were raised.

4.2 Call for patents

The following was read aloud to the assembly by Bill Sapsis:

"PLASA intends not to publish any standard that contains protected intellectual property, unless that information can be licensed by anyone for a reasonable fee. PLASA uses a process of open patent and copyright disclosures to implement its intent. PLASA does not conduct patent or copyright searches and does not warrant that its standards contain no protected intellectual property.

"In keeping with the open disclosures policy, I ask if anyone present wishes to notify this working group of the existence of a patent or copyright or other intellectual property that might protect material in a standard being developed by this working group. You need not be the holder of the patent or copyright to notify this working group of its existence."

No protected intellectual property was reported.

5 Approval of the agenda

Wendy Holt moved that the agenda be approved. The motion was seconded and approved by show of hands.

6 Old business

6.1 ANSI E1.1 - 2012, wire rope ladders

No news or action.

6.2 ANSI E1.2 - 2012, Entertainment Technology - Design, Manufacture and Use of Aluminum Trusses and Towers

Karl Ruling informed the group that E1.2 is posted for sale on the ESTA Foundation website and has been sent to ANSI for sale on their site as well.

6.3 ANSI E1.4 - 2009, Entertainment Technology--Manual Counterweight Rigging Systems This item was rolled over to **New Business** for discussion and possible action.

6.4 ANSI E1.6-1 - 2012, Entertainment Technology--Powered Hoist Systems No news or action.

6.5 BSR E1.6-2, Entertainment Technology--Design, Inspection, and Maintenance of Electric Chain Hoists for the Entertainment Industry

There were no public review comments offered in the last review.

Dan Culhane moved that BSR E1.6-2 be accepted as an American National Standard, with this action to be approved by letter ballot. The move was seconded and approved by a show of hands. A letter ballot will be forthcoming.

6.6 ANSI E1.6-3 - 2012, Safe Use of Electric Chain Hoists in the Entertainment Industry No news or action.

6.7 BSR E1.6-4, Control of Electric Chain Hoists in the Entertainment Industry

Comment resolution/next step?

Dan Culhane moved that the resolutions be accepted. The motion was seconded and approved by a show of hands with two abstentions. This was a supermajority.

Joe Champelli asked for a delay of any action on the revised draft standard, since he wanted time to share his concerns about the document with the task group. Instead, his concerns were discussed by the working group, which is the consensus body, and the document was modified at the meeting. Changes made include grammatical, semantic and elimination of redundancy, as well as a modification to the connector pin numbering in an annex.

Dan Culhane moved that the revised draft standard (Rig/2010-2008r2L) be offered for public review. The motion was seconded. The motion was approved by show of hands with two abstentions. This was a supermajority.

6.8 ANSI E1.8 - 2012, Entertainment Technology--Loudspeaker Enclosures Intended for Overhead Suspension--Classification, Manufacture and Structural Testing

Karl Ruling informed the group that ANSI's eStandards Store had received a request for copy, so they asked him for it, and he sent it to them. Thus, it can be purchased from ANSI's eStandards Store as well as from The ESTA Foundation.

6.9 ANSI E1.15 - 2006 (R2011), Entertainment Technology--Recommended Practices and Guidelines for the Assembly and Use of Theatrical Boom & Base Assemblies No news or action.

6.10 BSR E1.21 - 201x, Temporary Ground-Supported Overhead Structures Used To Cover Stage Areas and Support Equipment in the Production of Outdoor Entertainment Events *Update on public review vote, public review.*

The document will go to public review. The TSC has approved the motion.

6.11 ANSI E1.22 - 2009, Entertainment Technology - Fire Safety Curtain Systems

Dan Culhane had been put in charge of looking at evaluating it for revision or reaffirmation. (See the task group list from the last minutes) Harvey Sweet started a discussion of whether it should be a performance

or prescriptive standard and urged the group to make it be one or the other. Sapsis tasked the task group with making a recommendation after they meet. (They will need a meeting room for summer meeting.)

6.12 BSR E1.39 - 20xx, Entertainment Technology –Selection and Use of Personal Fall Arrest Systems on Portable Structures Used in the Entertainment Industry

Rocky Paulson moved that the comment resolutions (E1-39_ThrdRvwCmmnts-Resolutions-130205.pdf) be accepted. The motion was seconded and approved by a show of hands with two abstentions.

Rocky Paulson moved that the revised draft standard (BSRE1-39-2013-02-05a.pdf) be offered for public review. The motion was seconded and approved by a show of hands with one abstention.

6.13 BSR E1.43 - 201x, Live performer flying effect standard

Dan Lisowski reported the hours the group had worked on a first draft suitable for public review. An updated version of the document will be sent to the RWG with a request for comments. Those comments will be considered during the August meetings.

Some comments were offered on the draft document (E1-43 Perfomer Flying Progress 03-05-2013.pdf) at the meeting. Joe Champelli took notes to take back to the task group.

6.14 BSR E1.44 – 201x, Common Show File Exchange Format for Entertainment Industry Automation Control Systems -- Stage Machinery

Michael Lichter reported that a few people had offered comments so far. He is looking forward to having all the comments when the review ends 1 April.

6.15 Rigging Glossary

Chris Kaiser gave a report on the rigging glossary task group's work, and offered observations and recommendations on how words are used in RWG documents.

She recommended that we should make sure that words not used in documents are not listed in definitions. She also recommended the use of the Merriam-Webster's Dictionary, noting that the editors of that do a good job of defining everyday words.

Kaiser said that the task group had issues with our use of "competent" in that there were two different endings to the definition being used in various documents. The consensus was to change the end to read, "...and who is authorized to take prompt corrective measures to eliminate hazards."

There was a discussion of a way forward for this group, how to integrate checking for consistent use of words into our process. "The Word Police" was suggested as title no one likes. There was a discussion of a possible future standard that would be a recommended guide to the language used in documents.

6.16 BSR E1.47 - 201x Recommended Guidelines for Entertainment Rigging System Inspections Pete Svitavsky is appointed as the task group leader by Bill Sapsis, replacing Chris Kaiser.

Chris Kaiser suggested that a complete draft will be ready for review by the working group at the January 2014 meeting.

7 New business

7.1 Revising ANSI E1.4 - 2009

Karl Ruling reported his discovery that the standard doesn't require rope locks. Furthermore, how to deal with seismic load requirements in California is not clear.

What to do? See E1-4_revisions.pdf for a list of possible revisions and E1-4_2009.pdf for the existing document.

Richard Nix moved that we start the process of revising the standard. The motion was seconded and unanimously approved by a show of hands.

R. Duane Wilson said that the ASTC's code committee would like to see E1.4 become a standard that the ICC can reference.

There was a discussion of making all standards ICC-acceptable or just some of them. The general consensus of the group is that only some of our documents should be written with the ICC as the intended audience.

The proposed revisions outlined in E1-4_revisions.pdf were discussed and amended. Richard Nix moved that we accept the proposed revisions as amended (E1-4_revisions_R1). The motion was seconded and approved by a show of hands.

Richard Nix moved that at the end of the ANSI PINS period, the group forward the revised E1.4 document with the revisions incorporated to be voted on for public review by letter ballot. The motion was seconded and approved by a show of hands with ten opposed and two abstentions. The motion passed with the required supermajority.

7.2 Other new business

None.

8 Other business and announcements

8.1 NVBF NA 149-00-05 AA Maschinen

Michael Lichter reported that he has been voted into membership in the DIN equivalent of the RWG. Her reported that DIN 56950, the standard for stage machinery, has been split into two parts: DIN 56950-1 and 56950-2. The official publication dates for these is May 2013.

Lichter reported that there is work being done to create a pan-European CEN standard for rigging and stage machinery to replace the workshop agreement. Ron Bonner has put forth a work item on this with BSI.

8.2 Update on the Event Safety Alliance and the Event Safety Guide

Jim Digby reported that parts of *The Event Safety Guide* are in public review. The rigging chapter is not finished, but will be put out for review when available. He encouraged the group to download the document and get involved with this effort. The website from which the document can be downloaded is http://www.eventsafetyalliance.org/.

9 Schedule for future meetings

Bill Sapsis announced that the next meeting is scheduled for Thursday afternoon, 01 August 2013, at the D/FW Marriott Solana.
